

Alex Lloyd Superfund Euro F3000 Championship Dijon – September 12th 2004

In only his 4th Formula 3000 race, and for the second race in a row, Alex was untouchable all weekend, utterly dominating every single session.

Starting from pole, he shook off the ill fortune that has beset him to date, and simply drove away from the field, winning by over 10 seconds from his team mate, Jonny Reid. He didn't put a wheel wrong in the 40 lap race.

“It felt like the film Groundhog Day” he said afterwards. “Everything had gone exactly the same way as Donington. We were quickest all day - it was as if I had been given another chance to get a clean sweep and win.

“I've never seen Dijon before, and it's a wonderful track”, he continued. “The longest straight of any European circuit, followed by a series of never-ending bends, make it a challenging track to drive. I loved it. The team have done a fantastic job here – they have done all year – and I have to dedicate this victory to them”

Alex has now managed to secure backing to complete the last 3 races of the season. The winner's prize money in the Superfund-backed series is €10,000

The next race is at Zolder in Belgium next weekend, 19th September. It will be shown live on MotorsTV at 3:15pm CET (2:15pm UK time).
